- Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014 (WIOA) is the federal legislation that guides the public workforce system and provides funding to states through the Department of Labor's Employment & Training Administration
- Stark Tuscarawas Workforce Development Board serves our two-county local workforce area (Stark and Tuscarawas Counties)
- Agencies receiving funds under WIOA are required to be partners in the OhioMeansJobs centers
 - These partners sign a Memorandum of Understanding outlining the responsibilities of the partnership

JOB SEEKER SERVICES

WORKFORCE FUNDED TRAINING

- Workforce-funded training dollars are available through the OhioMeansJobs center to **eligible** young adults, dislocated workers, and adults
- Funded training supports those seeking **short-term** training for **In-Demand** careers
- Funding covers the cost of schooling/training as well as books, testing, and other program requirements
- Workforce-funded training dollars are budgeted yearly by the local workforce area

Services for Businesses

- Recruit qualified job seekers
- Employers are assigned a recruiter to assist with job posting; positions are posted on the www.OhioMeanJobs.com website
- Provide resume pre-screening assistance to an employer's qualifications and offer candidate referrals
- Social Media Outreach/Promotional assistance
- On-site Recruitment and Job Fairs



What Employers are expecting

-Etiquette

- Respect
- Communication
 - Pre, during, and post employment
- Honesty

-Attitude

- Willingness to learn
 - Training, upskilling, etc.
- Motivated to work



Job seeker tips



- Know what you value and seek employers with similar priorities
- Use multiple avenues to reach your employer of choice
 - OMJ, Indeed, LinkedIn, job fairs, open interviews, phone/email, etc.
- Provide a cover page to elaborate on your transferrable skills, explain any employment gaps, and further explain anything in your resume that might need elaborated on.
- Research the market value of your position before negotiating compensation
